Below is a list of a number of resolutions presented for voting at the Grand Lodge Convention in New Orleans:

To change the Office of Lodge Tiler from an elected position to an appointed position. Passed.

To authorize a Lodge to require its Officers to memorize the Opening, Closing and Inititatory Rituals under penalty of removal from Office. Failed.

To reinstate the Grand Lodge and Local Lodge Public Relations Committees. Passed.

To allow the governing body of the Home, Club or other facility to suspend or revoke club privileges of a visiting Member without the requirement of a club suspension hearing. Failed.

To allow a vote to be taken by secret ballot instead of the voting signs of an Elk by a majority vote of the Lodge. Passed.

To allow a Lodge to hold regular Lodge meetings monthly, semi monthly, trimonthly or weekly as provided by approved Lodge By-laws. Failed.
