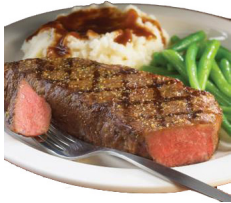
MEAL OF THE MONTH

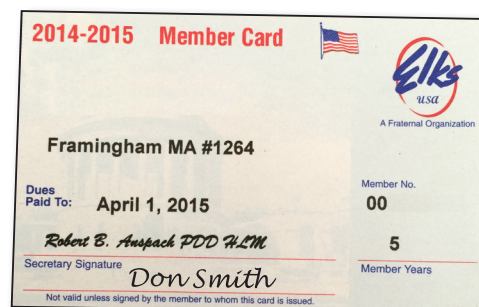
